How to Start A Fundraiser

1. Choose how you will raise money.

4. Run your fundraiser!

Freedom Event Ideas

Here are a few fundraising event ideas for all ages which you can run with as is or tweak to make your own! Our top tip is to make sure it's something that you can do with your friends or family as a group to get more people involved; more people = more funds raised!

- Participate in a fun run or marathon
- Run a car wash in your local community
- Throw a second hand charity auction
- Host a high tea event/garden party!
- Put together a games night & charge an entrance fee at the front door
- Do a sausage sizzle at your kid's next sports match on the weekend.
- Host an art exhibition in your home!
- Got musical talent? Run a benefit gig!
- Organise a cocktail evening
- Put together an office spread work lunch; asking people to bring a plate to share and a gold coin to donate!

Collecting & Donating Funds

Transparency throughout the process is key to being above reproach in running your event. Because of this, it is important to think about *how* you will collect and then donate the money you raise, *before* you raise it.

Using Cash:

If you intend to ask your participants to donate using cash, the easiest way to make your donation afterwards is to go to your local bank after the event and put the funds into your account and then donate online via our website or directly into *The Freedom Project*'s bank account.

In order to be accountable, you will need to keep track of each individual donation - and possibly by whom it was made - and email us both this information as well as the receipt of the original deposit into your account prior to the transfer.

Paying online:

Perhaps an easier way of giving, however, is to ask your participants to donate online during the event. At the bottom of our giving form is an option for comments where they can say they are part of your what prompted you to give today?*

Some Fundraising Milestones to Aim for

Every \$100 you raise

can help our field team perform a rescue operation, including training undercover police, victim rescue and processing.

Every \$250 you raise

can help keep one child in our Sports For Life trafficking-prevention program for a year.

Every \$1000 you raise

can help keep one rescued woman in our safe home for a month, including vocational training, fulltime housing, food & clothing, 24-hour security, legal support, trauma support and medical care.
